SUMMARY

The 2012 Cyclesense League draws to a close with 368 rides, down mainly to two events having to be cancelled due to bad weather. There was good support from Seacroft Wheelers, Wetherby Wheelers and Yorkshire RC. Yorkshire Velo did not give the same support as last year with only John Woods and Dave Virden turning up regularly, and Leeds Westfield were down to just two riders. There were 77 individual riders as against 80 last year.

A new name tops the table this year with Mac Wontorowski, Wetherby Wheelers on 268 points with Pete Nixon, Seacroft Wheelers and John Woods, Yorkshire Velo sharing second place with 261. Mike Cross won the second claim competition with a last minute performance, relegating Peter McGowen into second place with Nick Barnes taking 3rd spot. There was a shortage of female competitors this year with only Julie Smithies and Abby Parkinson riding. Chris Barnes won the youth section, here again with very few younger riders taking part. Can we hope that our wonderful showing in the Olympics will encourage more women and young people to take up riding at a competitive level?

On to the veterans with a win once again for Mike Shacklock. The new veterans standard tables have reduced his plus figure from last year's magnificent 6.916 down to 3.317 but still a very worthy effort. Steve Smith takes second place with a plus of 3.02. Other vets are: John Woods +2.59, Mac Wontorowski +2.41, John Smithies +2.38, Stu Wood +2.15, Steve Ward +2.11, Keith Storey +1.54, Bob Tate +1.38, Steve Mooring +1.15, Kevin Spink +.34 and minus figures for Howard Blakeley --0.05, Andrew Lee --0.09, Peter Walls --0.29. Richard Barker --0.42, Julie Smithies --2.47, Stuart Whittle --2.55 and Chris Beetham --2.59.
